

In 2003, the Liberian civil war, which had destroyed much of the country over its 14 year duration, came to an end. Over the course of the war, 250,000 Liberians were killed, many thousands were left disabled. Half of the country population had fled the country as refugees during those 14 years, and over a million were internally displaced in camps around the country.



Since 2005, Caring for All has been laying the groundwork for sustainable and effective services for those who need them most. With limited resources, CFA volunteers are working in the outskirts of Monrovia and the rural community of Lofa to strengthen the situation of Liberians in these communities such that they may become thriving citizens in a new, peaceful, and reconstructed Liberia.

Women's Empowerment Program

Caring for All realizes the incredible influence and economic force that skilled and entrepreneurial women can have on a community and through professional training in marketable skills, and professional counseling to help them through these struggles, we are working to provide the skills and resources to spur that potential into motion.



Caring for All's "Stand Up" program focuses on bringing opportunity to the multitude of children in our communities through the provision of elementary education.

Stand up for Kids Youth Program

We aim to do this directly by providing elementary education at Caring for All Elementary in Thinker Village outside of Monrovia. CFA Elementary already provides education to 135 students from nursery school to 6th grade.

Yet resources are limited both for parents and for the school. CFA Elementary is still seeking chalkboards, desks, and tables will make teaching and learning more effective. As Caring for All continues to build up this program, it continues to search for those who are willing to support the work we are doing.



Public Health Program

In partnership with community members in Brewerville, Jacob Town, Lofa and hospitals in the United States, CFA is working to establish a clinic and community health education program that will greatly improve the health and well-being of Brewerville's, Jacob Town and Lofa residents. The CFA Clinic will offer general medical assistance to the communities we serve, including a spectrum of care from malaria treatments to infant delivery holding firm to a commitment that all people should have access to quality health care.



The CFA community health education program will focus primarily on the preven-

tion and treatment of Cancer and HIV/AIDS. Trained staff will train community leaders in the causes and means of HIV/AIDS transmission and positive steps toward its prevention. We intend to provide information materials and practical resources.
